

Frequently asked questions

A full breakfast, both continental and cooked to order a la carte, is included with your accommodation, this is complimentary. Breakfast is served from 7.30am to 9.30am in the dining room.

Check in is from 2pm. If you would like to check in earlier just shoot us an email requesting an earlier check in. If you are going to arrive after 7pm please let us know in advance approximate time of arrival.

If you wish to reserve a table for dinner, please call or email, bookings are essential, please let us know if you would like to dine by 4.30pm for same day dining, as we are only a small team at the Inn! The menu is on our web site under the menu tab. We cook to the rhythm of the seasons and our menu on the web site is indicative only of what will be served. The menu reflects both the season and local availability. We will either serve share platters of food to graze on or we will have a banquet if we are busy. The share platters are equivalent to 3 courses. Feel free to email us any dietary requirements and allergies at least 72 hours prior as a preference. How to get to Girraween Country Inn:

New England Highway

Coming from either north or south, take the turnoff to Eukey Road at Ballandean Tavern. We are 8km along Eukey Road. Please note there is no phone signal past Symphony Hill winery. Look for our directional sign before Symphony Hill that's says 3kms. Symphony Hill Winery is on the right-hand side. We are approximately 2 kms past Symphony Hill Wines, on the same side of the road. Look out for our blue directional sign, on the left-hand side of the road, saying Girraween Country Inn 200 metres. Look for deep blue rendered fence and wrought iron gates with multiple flags and a long driveway and a two storey building at the end of the driveway, with all the lights on.

Coming from Stanthorpe

Go over the Stanthorpe bridge and take the 2nd turn to the left, the Storm King Dam turnoff. This road becomes Eukey Road. Drive 20km along Eukey Road, until you come to a township called Eukey. Keep driving another 5kms and we are on the left-hand side. Look out for our blue sign, on the left-hand side of the road, saying Girraween Country Inn 300 metres. Look for deep blue rendered fence and wrought iron gates with multiple flags, on

the left-hand side of the road and a long driveway and a two storey building at the end of the driveway, with all the lights on.

Telephone, Wifi and Electric vehicle Charger

We are also please to advise we have upgraded our wifi service and wifi is available throughout the Inn and Chalet. We now also have full access to Telstra phone and wifi services at the Inn and the system has been significantly upgraded. Telstra service is now available at the Chalet, wifi is available using your own data on your telstra phone. Wifi for all phone providers is available at the Inn. New Electric Vehicle charger installed and available for guests use.

Our restaurant is open 7 days a week for dinner and breakfast. Bookings essential by 4.30pm for dining. Please advise how many courses and your choices by 4.30pm as we are only a small team at the Inn. Vegetarian and Vegan Menus available, 24 hours notice is required. We feature food cooked in our European smokehouse. Free Range Organic Crackling Pork Shoulder and Brisket with Hickory Smoky Barbecue Sauce. We use fresh and local ingredients, collaborate with local producers, suppliers and services. We are at the heart of the Granite Belt food bowl and want to share our passions for quality food and produce with you. Dinner \$77 for 3 courses, \$66 for 2 courses, \$50 for 1 course. Breakfast to the public is \$40 per person includes continental buffet and cooked to order a la carte breakfast.

Highly recommend you book into these restaurants well prior to your stay as they book out in advance.
